SUBMISSION

Authors are invited to submit three hard copies of their papers to:

Ensure that the soft copy and hard copy match exactly. Keep a backup for reference and safety.

All articles submitted to the Journal must be original and should in no way violate any existing copyright law and should contain nothing of a libelous or scandalous nature. The Editorial Board decision is final.

ORGANISATION OF THE MANUSCRIPTS

The articles should be in good grammatical English. All pages should be numbered consecutively, with page numbers at the bottom center. The first line of each paragraph in the text and of all captions should be indented

Manuscripts should be typed in Times New romans font, 12 points, single-spacing on one side of A4 paper with 2.5cm margins and should be accompanied by:

Title: Capital letters.

Authors: Full Name (Surname first) and address (including institutional affiliation, of author(s). **Abstract**: An abstract of not more than 250 words that includes objectives, methods, and results and conclusions.

Keywords: A maximum of 8 key words or phrases to be used for indexing purposes. **Introduction:** Should briefly indicate the objectives of the study and provide enough background information to clarify why the study was undertaken including citations

Materials and Methods: Should be brief but sufficient to allow other investigators to repeat the research including citations where necessary

Results: This section should present clearly but succinctly the experimental findings. Only results essential to establish the main points of the work should be included

Discussion and Conclusion: Including citations in discussion

Acknowledgments: Provide information sufficient to identify sources of support, technical assistance, and Intellectual contributions not associated with authorship.

References: Each citation in the text must be noted by surname and year .in parentheses and must appear in the reference section, as alphabetic order. Example for citation in the text; a) for single author (John, 2014), b) for two authors (Good and Fine, 2001), c) more than two authors (Sule *et al.*, 2000).

TABLES AND FIGURES

Each table must have its title and each figure, its caption. Figures and tables must be in serial number (Fig. 1, Table 1, etc.). Tables (with titles) and figures (with captions) must be separated from the text and put at the end of the manuscript.

Artwork should be of good quality photocopies, blue ink or pencil is not acceptable. Letters in the artwork must be quite readable after reduction. Original line drawing and two clear copies should be submitted.

REFERENCES

The manuscript should include a reference 1ist containing only those references cited in the text. The references should be typed in single-spacing and arranged in alphabetical order according to the name of the first author. Works by the same author should be listed in order of publication.

References should follow the current APA format.

NOTE: All citations must be in the Hanging Indent Format with the first line flush to the left margin and all other lines indented.
